The European Commission has appointed everis to conduct a consultation study on the digitalisation of company law across European Union (EU) Members States.

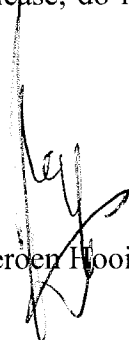
